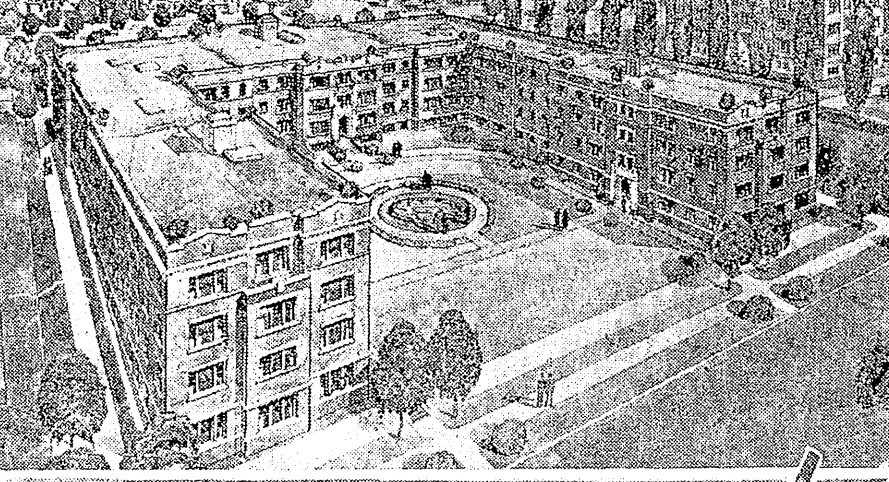

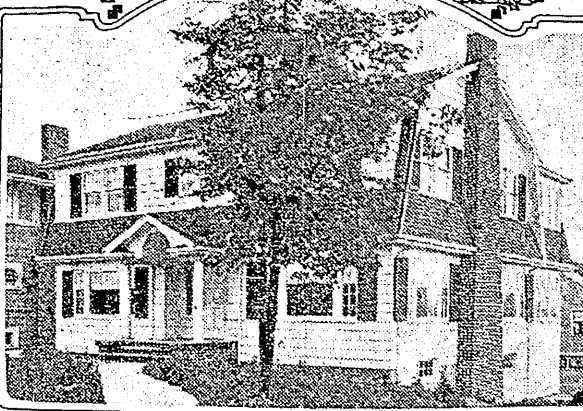
Partners Puzzle British Builders

BIG DIRIGIBLE IS COMING

ZR-2 TO VISIT SEATTLE IN FALL OR NEXT SUMMER.

Arrangements for Handling Giant Dirigible, Which Will Cross Atlantic, Being Rushed.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Saturday, May 14.—America's greatest flying ship, the ZR-2, will visit Seattle this fall or next summer. The vessel, which is the largest rigid dirigible...

Seattle will be included in the list of cities to be visited, said an official of the bureau today. "The Navy has considerable interest in the Northwest, because of the location of the Bremerton naval base. It is impossible at this time, of course, to give any adequate idea of the date of the visit."

Secretary Denby today authorized the following: "The Navy is building a huge hangar to accommodate the ZR-2 and her sister ship, the ZR-3, which is to be constructed there. This hangar will be the largest in the United States with accommodations for an airship of the size of these and the mooring apparatus for them."

The great features of this "mooring" proposition is the fact that it requires from 200 to 300 men to moor a ship on the ground, or to unmoor it in and out of the hangar. Six men only were required to manipulate the mooring apparatus in a quick, safe and economical manner for carrying out these operations wherever desired.

The method of mooring is extremely simple. The dirigible approaches a mooring mast, a cable which runs from a winch from the ground to the top of the dirigible through the cylinder, is led down again to the ground, where a ball is attached 500 feet from the mast in the direction from which the airship is approaching. The ball is attached to the end of the cable, one man at the winch, and three to five others in the dirigible to operate the cable and machinery.

Always Trimmed Down. An airship moored to a mast must always be kept trimmed down by the stern. And this is true when in the air or on the ground. Otherwise the gusts of wind downward on the bow of the ship would throw her overboard and she would be sure to "whip in the air."

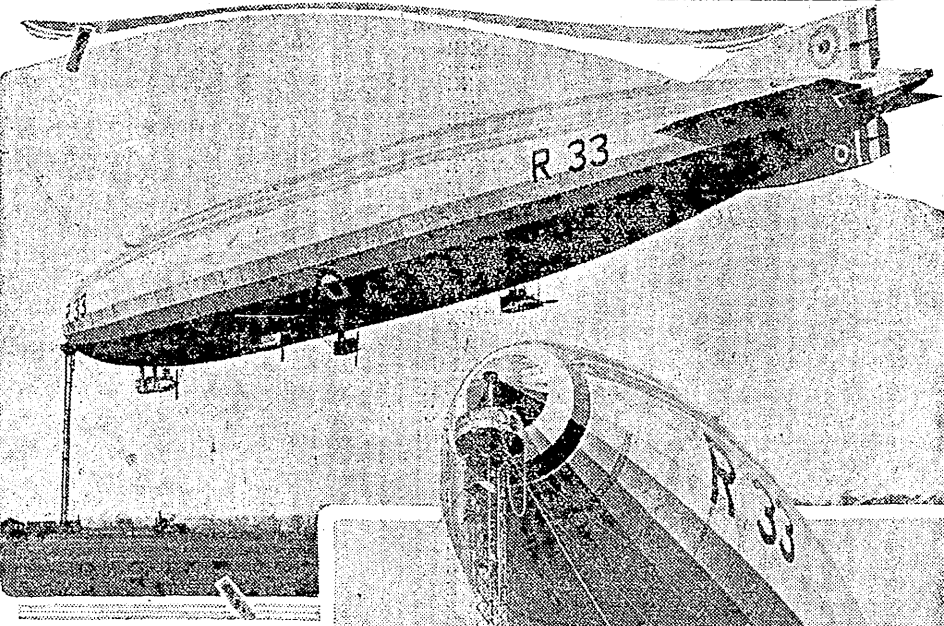

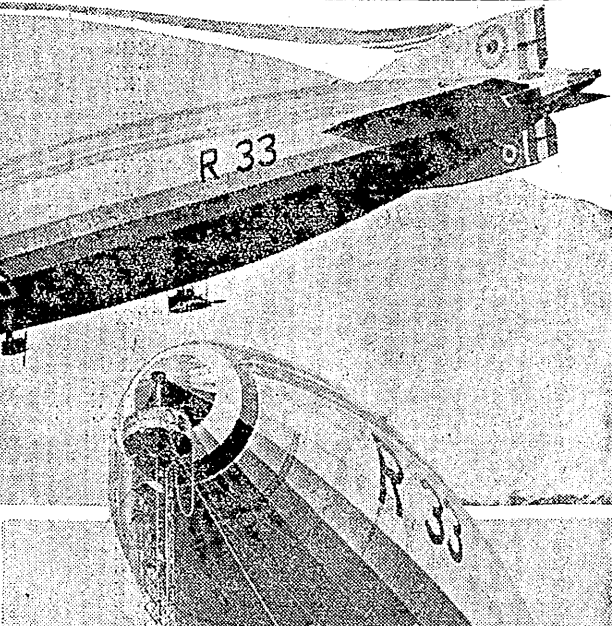
